Ancient Egyptian writings like The Maxims of Ptahhotep explored ethics, justice, and moral behavior long before Greek philosophy.

Many philosophers were also scientists. Aristotle studied biology, Descartes explored mathematics and physics, and Leibniz invented calculus independently of Newton.

Plato's real name wasn't Plato.

His birth name was Aristocles. "Plato" was a nickname meaning "broad."
