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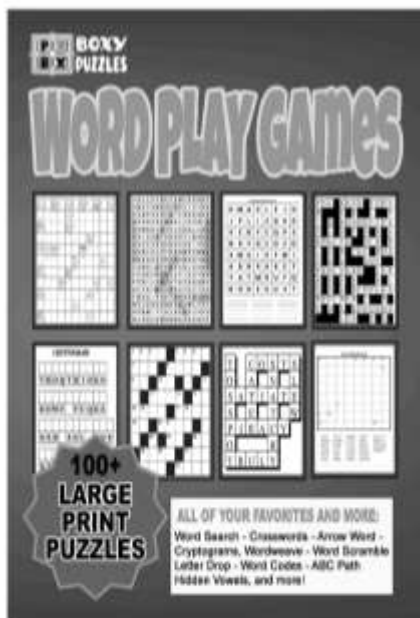
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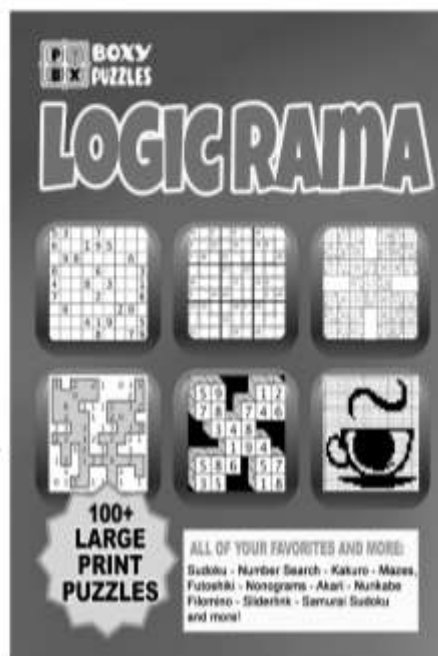

# How to Play Tents & Trees

In this puzzle, the trees are already placed on the grid. Your job is to place the tents. Each tent belongs to one tree, and every tree needs exactly one tent.

## The Rules

### 1. Each tree must have one tent.

Every tree on the grid is paired with one tent.

### 2. Tents must be next to a tree.

A tent can go directly above, below, left, or right of a tree.

A tent cannot be placed diagonally from its tree.

### 3. Tents cannot touch each other.

Tents may not touch side by side, up and down, or diagonally.

### 4. Use the numbers on the sides.

The numbers beside each row and column tell you how many tents must go in that row or column.

### 5. Every puzzle has one correct solution.

You can solve it by using logic and careful elimination.

## Helpful Solving Tips

Start with rows or columns that show **0**. Since no tents can go there, you can mark those squares as empty.

Next, look for rows or columns with high numbers. These often give strong clues about where tents must go.

When you place a tent, mark the squares around it as empty because no other tent can touch it.









Also remember: a tree can only connect to a tent directly beside it, not diagonally.
